Pesca Maya, Ascension Bay, Yucatan Peninsula

In the early part of January WO is attempting to put together our first group trip to Mexico for some spectacular sight fishing to powerful and illusive species. We plan to bring a group of 7 anglers to experience this extraordinarily diverse section of ascension bay on México's Yucatán peninsula. The lodge is located 90 miles south of Cancun in the 1.3 million acre Sian Ka'an (Mayan for "where the sky is born") Biosphere Reserve. The entire area boasts some of the Caribbean's greatest flats fishing for bonefish, permit, snook, tarpon and others, (APRIL - JUNE Bonefishing and permit fishing remain excellent, more numbers of tarpon are seen on the flats and coves) as well as reef and offshore fishing (in season). Flats' fishing is from locally built skiffs and pangas ranging in size from 18-23 feet, powered by 40 hp outboards. Pesca Maya boats carry 2 anglers, one guide and one apprentice guide. John Jinishian will be the representative from the shop on this trip and has an ample amount of experience fishing the area, visiting Pesca on 3 separate occasions in the past few years with great results. The fishery supplies great opportunities for anglers of all ages and skill levels ranging from the pursuit of illusive permit to the ghostly bonefish and a wide variety in between.

The dates for your 5-night/4-day fishing trip are for January 7 - 12, 2011.

Arrive: January 7  
Fish: January 8, 9, 10 & 11  
Depart: January 12

We'll be able to confirm the 2010 rate for your trip in 2011 by receiving a 50% deposit by June 18, 2010. Typically, lodge rates go up about 4-6% each year.

The standard rates:  
2010 cost for a 5-night / 4-day fishing package = \$2,205.00.

The discount rate:  
for a 5-night / 4-day fishing package w/ deposits received by June 14, 2010 =  
\$1,984.50 per person based on double occupancy accommodations and a shared boat / guide daily.

We highly recommend trip cancellation insurance (<http://www.angleradventures.com/travelex2010.pdf>). The premium required to cover up to \$2,000 = \$170 per person.

The total per person cost including insurance is \$2,154.50

Group of 8 anglers.\*

The above rates include: round-trip ground transfer from Cancun Airport to Pesca Maya; lodging in beach front cabana with private bath and air conditioning; three meals a day; flats skiff with native guide daily; use of lodge's tackle (offshore trips only); use of lodge's fly tying facility and materials; beverages, table wine, beer, liquor.

The above rates do not include: air travel to Cancun; baggage overweight charges; airport departure tax; laundry bills and other items of a personal nature (NOTE: cellular phone service is available at camp for emergency use. Long distance and cellular charges will be added to your final bill); tackle; fishing license (118 pesos per person per day / 256 pesos per person per week, paid in cash at the lodge-\$23 per/week); gratuities for guides (suggested \$40 per boat per day) and kitchen/housekeeping staff (suggested \$20 per person per day); special transfer costs necessitated by late arriving, early departing or missed flights (\$200 per vehicle trip); optional trips to

freshwater lagoon and Mayan Ruins (arranged in advance with resident manager).
